Drama at Columcille Columcille drama group performs regular theatre productions at Columcille and benefits from the in-house venue, stage, lighting — plus our joinery and art groups making the scenery and props. We have been very pleased to receive grants from several charitable trusts, contributing to a wheelchair lift for accessing the stage, upgrade of the hall floor and venue running costs. The wheelchair lift will enable wheelchair users to more fully participate in theatre productions and we are very pleased to have this facility.

Scotmid East Regional Committee awarded a grant of **£500** towards the costs of purchasing the wheelchair lift and resurfacing the Hall floor. We also received much appreciated grants from the Screwfix Foundation, Albert Hunt Trust, Bruce Wake Charity, Gordon Fraser and Sir Jules Thorn Charitable Trusts, towards these costs.

shop is the hub of production for scenery for plays, working in partnership with the craft group. The joinery also enables individual projects, items to sell at the Autumn Fair and a refurbishing space for items of furniture. Skill and creative opportunity are central aims.



Music for ALL continues to run 6 courses each week—5 in Edinburgh and 1 in Bonnyrigg, Midlothian. 115 people participate in making music each week. A grant from the Cordis Trust is enabling us to work with Braidburn and Oaklands Schools in partnership working, in accreditation for Music for ALL.

Columcille Ceilidh Band plays on—though choosing fewer gigs and preferring to play for events for community groups and projects benefiting people with learning disability. We do not have back up funding for the band so all costs need to be met from income, which is an ongoing challenge. We are planning to apply for funding to enable us to fulfil our central aim of enabling lower cost ceilidhs for groups benefitting people with learning disabilities.
